

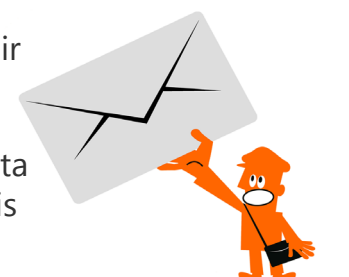

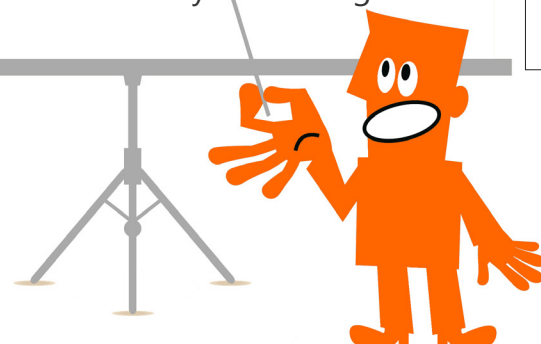


Keep track of data owners & their contact info.

1. Your staff (data owners) simply upload their data on to the portal

3. You glance at the dashboard while it automates reminders to your colleagues

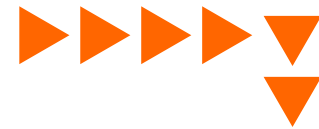


View your organisation's data at a glance - including its frequency, due date and owner



1. Did you know that data is needed from all over your organisation?

From GIS to Finance - transparency data needs to be published from multiple departments. So tracking who has to do what and when by is really important.



2. Do you know what data needs to be published?

There are 13 data themes to publish+ a once off data set:

Annually

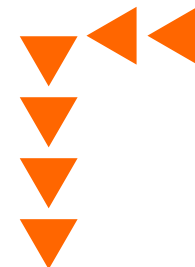
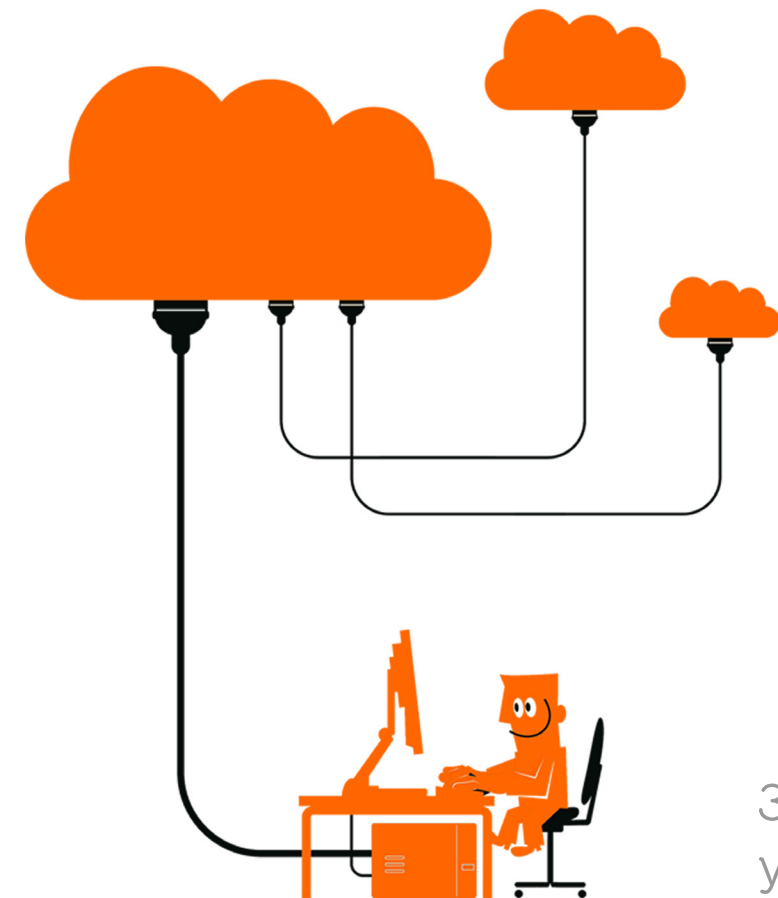
- Local Authority land
- Grants to community & social organisations
- Organisation charts
- Trade union facility time
- Parking accounts
- Parking spaces
- Senior salaries
- Constitution
- Pay multiple
- Fraud

Quarterly

- Expenditure exceeding £500
- Government procurement card transactions
- Procurement info e.g. contracts and tenders

Once Only

- Waste Contracts - one off requirement for current contracts. All future ones will come under the procurement info theme.



3. Do you know how you will publish your data or where it needs to go?

Some the data must be published to your organisation's website, everything else simply needs to be made available online in some capacity.

We suggest uploading to data.gov as its a great central catalogue for local government data. Our CompliancyView service publishes there for you. You can then link to your data from any web page you like.



4. Do you know your deadlines?

31st Dec 2014

First round of Quarterly data and the Once Only data must be published by this date.

2nd Feb 2015

First round of Annual data must be published.

Data must be published no later than 1 month past its deadline. Within these timescales you can publish at any point.
